Moving on I can report the councils continuing support for the following:

- 2. The Botolph Green Festival. Which this year has had to be postponed due to the on-going crisis.
- **3.** Orton Silver Tops which provide a valuable service for the elder member of the parish to meet over a tea of coffee.
- **4.** The success of the bulky waste still continues to be popular with both residents of Orton Longueville and Waterville parishes.
- **5.** O.L.P.C Under Section S137 Grant LGA1972 has given a Covid-19 cash grant to Peterborough Food Bank and Peterborough Council for Voluntary Service to help local residents. Both have seen demand grow due to this Pandemic.
- 6. Also I can confirm that the ongoing works at OPCC have been completed; the rear fences being fully installed, the front security has also been upgraded with new fencing and the introduction of a new height restriction barrier all in keeping with the present gate, and last but not least the completion of the access bridge into the ground being wider for better turning into the ground.

Also the New Plans for the Gloucester Centre revised plans have been submitted.
